# **FORCE Open Day**

Our Annual Open Day is on Sunday 7th September and we hope you all have it in your diaries. The day will start with a dog show in Kneller Gardens from 12-30pm and all dogs and owners are welcome to enter on the day. Activities will continue across our sites from 2pm in Mereway Nature Park and Craneford Fields with information, herb walks and food tasting for adults; story telling, face painting and lots of fun activities for children. The Rifle Club will be open for **shooting practice** and tea & cakes and there will be exhibitions of produce on Marsh Farm Allotments. Come along, bring a picnic and meet your neighboursand enjoy a pint of locally brewed Crane Sundancer from Twickenham Fine Ales.

FORCE volunteers will be preparing the sites on Saturday 6th September and we'll be on site from 9-30 on the Sunday to set up the stalls. The success of this event is very dependent on having enough volunteers, particularly on the Sunday morning, to erect tents, gazebos, etc. So, if it is at all possible for you to spare some time to help it would be very much **appreciated**. Also any donations of cakes, etc. for the tea stall would be welcomed.

## **Crane Riverside Park**

The **interim report** for this project has been released and is available on our web-site along with an Executive Summary. The report has been well received in presentations to Richmond and Hounslow Councils as well as the GLA. We are hopeful that a new park, incorporating many of the areas along the Crane including the existing Crane Park, can be created in the relatively near future and be provided with Metropolitan Park status. The project is continuing and we expect to have the final report by the end of 2008.

## Development proposals at Mogden Sewage Works and Richmond College

FORCE has submitted a formal response to the planning application to increase substantially the capacity of Mogden Sewage Treatment Works and we are meeting with Thames Water to discuss our concerns in the near future. FORCE is currently submitting a response to the draft Development Brief for the proposed Richmond Upon Thames College re**development**. Both these responses will be posted on our web-site.

#### **Kneller Gardens Pavilion**

We are pleased to say that the Council has given the **go-ahead**, subject to planning permission, to renovate the pavilion at Kneller Gardens, complete with public toilets and a kiosk. Many thanks are due to the Friends of Kneller Gardens for their work on this project. The building work is due to be completed by the end of March 2009. The design plans for the proposed renovations will be available for park users to view at the Dog Show in Kneller Gardens on 7th September.
